2022-2023 State of Illinois School Health Requirements

Sport Participants-----3RD THRU 8TH GRADE PLEASE READ

A current **Physical** or **Sports Physical** within the last 365 days is required before participation in sports practice or games is allowed. Physicals are good for 365 days and sports physicals are good for 395 days.

Preschool and New Pre-K

- **Certificate of Child Health Examination (Physical) Form** – Due on August 1, 2022 and dated within one year of the first day of school.

Kindergarten

- **Certificate of Child Health Examination (Physical) Form** – Due on August 1, 2022 and dated within one year of the first day of school.
- **Vision Form** – Due by October 15, 2022 and dated within one year of the first day of school.
- **Dental Form** – Due by May 15, 2023 and dated after November 15, 2021

Second Grade

- **Dental Form** – Due by May 15, 2023 and dated after November 15, 2021

Sixth Grade

- **Certificate of Child Health Examination (Physical) Form** – Due on August 1, 2022 and dated within one year of the first day of school.
- **Dental Form** – Due by May 15, 2023 and dated after November 15, 2021

Transfer Students

- **Certificate of Child Health Examination (Physical) Form** – Due on or before August 1, 2022 and dated within one year of the first day of school. If transferring in during the school year, Physical is due before the student begins attending school.
- **Vision Form** – Due by October 15, 2022 and dated within one year of the first day of school.
- **Dental Form** – Due by May 15, 2023 and dated after November 15, 2021.

Religious Exemptions

Parents requesting immunization exemption based on religious reasons **MUST** submit the ILLINOIS CERTIFICATE OF RELIGIOUS EXEMPTION TO REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS AND/OR EXAMINATIONS FORM. The form must be filled out and signed by the child's healthcare provider as well as parents.

ANY STUDENT REQUIRING MEDICATION DURING SCHOOL (asthma, allergy, diabetic, etc): To ensure the safety of our children in case of a medical emergency, we require a current **Plan of Action** and **Administration of Medications** forms filled out by the child's healthcare provider as well as a **Medication Request** form filled out by the parent. All medications must be turned in to the office and be **NEW/UNOPENED**. Students are not allowed to keep medications in their backpacks. Medication must remain in the office.
